

## Our Continuing Efforts

Pandemic. Yes, it is a very scary word. However, it is not a new word for us. As with prior pandemics, we must first be smart in avoiding possible exposure. Secondly, we must be diligent in our personal care and hygiene. Last, but certainly not least, remember ... This too shall pass.

The priority of Kiddies Kollege Christian Center has been and will continue to be educating our students in an environment that is nurturing, supportive, and safe for all students and staff. We continue these efforts to shield our students and staff by practicing social distancing and implementing enhanced practices and procedures that will benefit students and staff.

The single most impactful change has been restricting access to the building. Building access is now restricted to staff and students only. Students and staff must wash their hands before entering the building. Student Temperatures are taken at drop off, at 10 am, and at 3 pm. In order to adhere to Social Distancing protocol, our Wednesday morning Chapel Service has been suspended until further notice. However, classrooms will begin each day with a brief, age-appropriate devotional period. During nap, the children are spaced at least 6 feet apart from each other. Children are spaced out during table activities and lunch. Activities are done in smaller groups. Staff are required to wear masks during the day. Lastly, all children are required to wear face masks at all times except for lunch and nap time.

## Morning Drop Off

- Parents are to bring their children into the foyer where they will be met by a KKCC staff member.
- That staff member will take the child's temperature. If there are signs of a fever, the child will not be permitted to enter stay. Parents should not leave unless the staff member has checked the child's temperature.
- Each parent is to sign his/her name and write the entry time in the appropriate space following their child's name. Do not write in your child's name. If your child's name is not on the sign-in sheet notify administration.
- The student will be escorted to his/her room.

## Afternoon Pick-Up

- If no staff member is present, parents are to press the buzzer in the foyer.
- A staff member will escort each child to the foyer to meet the parents.
- Parent should sign their child out while waiting for their child.
